Does Your Club Need a Liquor Licence?

To help your Club work out whether or not it needs to get a Liquor Licence for a club event, RUSU Clubs has developed a Google form.

Use the form to work out if your club should get a Liquor Licence for its event.

You can use the “back” function to work out how you can change your plans so you don’t need a Licence.

You don’t need to submit the form once you’ve completed it.
