RULING ON SGM CAMPAIGNING

Student General Meetings are not to be utilised for campaigning for the RUSU elections and failure to adhere to this directive will result in significant penalties for individual candidates and electoral teams.

This means that individuals students are not permitted to wear campaign t-shirts, utilise electoral team logos as backgrounds in the meeting or engage in any kind of activity that can be considered campaigning throughout the meeting.

There will be particularly stringent penalties applied to election participants who engage in campaigning at the SGM in an organised and predetermined manner.

Determination of what is considered campaigning is at the discretion of the Returning Officer and will not be subject to discussion by students in attendance at the meeting. Any students who engage in campaigning will be issued with a warning before being directed to leave the meeting immediately.

The Returning Officer will be in attendance to enforce this ruling.

If any election participants have questions or need clarification around what is allowable behaviour please contact the returning officer in advance of the meeting.
